1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- a. Potential based on a weekly draw that could go for 50 weeks
- b. Must be at least 18 years of age to play.
- c. Any current member of the Ancaster AM Rotary Club are not permitted to purchase tickets.
- d. Any winner who is paid a prize agrees to grant the Ancaster AM Rotary Club an irrevocable right to publish, through all types of media broadcasting , including the internet, for the purposes of promoting the win, their full name, hometown and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights. The winner who is paid a prize also gives to the Rotary Club of Ancaster AM the right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide. The winner shall have no claim against the Rotary Club of Ancaster AM for invasion of privacy or any other ground(s) by reason of the publication or broadcasting of their name, hometown or photograph or information voluntarily provided by the winner.
- e. The winner will provide their full name, address and phone number to the Rotary Club of Ancaster AM for reporting requirements to the City of Hamilton. The address and phone number will NOT be made public.
- f. Once the Ace of Spades is revealed, the game is concluded and the City of Hamilton is notified immediately.
- g. The raffle operates under the terms and conditions of the City of Hamilton.

2. LOTTERY PROCEEDS

The Rotary Club Of Ancaster AM has submitted a list of potential recipients of lottery proceeds to the City of Hamilton with the licence application. All potential recipients are located within Hamilton and when funds are disbursed the amount and recipient will be announced prior to the next Thursday draw.

3. TICKET SALES

- a. Must be at least 18 years of age to play.
- b. Tickets are only valid for the draw date as printed on the ticket.
- c. Tickets are \$5.00 each.
- d. Tickets will be sold during the week of the draw by the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 163 and by members of the Ancaster AM Rotary Club. Tickets will be available for purchase each week immediately following the weekly draw.
- e. The purchaser must:
 - Ensure their ticket is filled out completely.
 - Complete the ticket stub, including name, contact information and one (1) envelope number. Enter a valid envelope number (1 to 52) from the list of available numbers supplied by the seller.

- f. To ensure no duplicate tickets are produced, the following process will be utilized:
 - A spreadsheet will be used to track the ticket numbers printed for each week's draw.
 - A different colour will be used for tickets for each week.
 - The numbers will be verified against the spreadsheet
 - We will also check before the following weeks tickets are printed.
 - We will also be following the OLG reporting document 6044E Catch the Ace Raffle Report.

4. DRAW TIME AND LOCATION

- a. The draw will be held at 6:45PM on Thursdays at the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 163 located at 435 Limeridge Road East, Hamilton, Ontario.
- b. Each Thursday one winning ticket will be drawn at random from that week's ticket sales.
- c. Only one (1) ticket will be drawn each week.
- d. Purchaser of the drawn ticket does not need to be present at the draw location to win.
- e. All draws are video recorded and posted on the Ancaster AM Rotary Facebook account. Recording will show the name and envelope number on the winning ticket.

5. DRAW RULES

- a. Draw Prize and Progressive Jackpot amounts will be announced prior to each draw.
- b. At 6:45 pm one (1) ticket stub will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold that week, the envelope number shown on the ticket will be opened. Distribution of the weekly ticket sales revenue is as follows:
 - 20% to the winning ticket holder;
 - 30% will be added to the jackpot;
 - 50% will go to the Ancaster AM Rotary Club.
- c. If the drawn ticket does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number, the Rotary Club will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number indicated on the ticket. The holder will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed. If unsuccessful in contacting the holder, the lowest remaining envelope number is selected by the Rotary Club.
- d. The winning ticket holder will win 20% of the weekly ticket sales and a chance to draw for the current round's Catch The Ace jackpot.
- e. If the Ace of Spades is selected, the winner receives the amount in the Catch the Ace jackpot. This will conclude the series of draws for this raffle.

- f. If the Ace of Spades is not selected the card and envelope number are removed from the subsequent draws and are destroyed.
- g. The winning ticket holder will be notified by phone and advised when and where he/she can claim their prize. Photo identification will be required to claim any prize. All prizes will be paid by cheque, in Canadian funds, to the person named on the winning ticket.

6. DRAW RULES – WEEK 50 ONLY

- a. If after 49 weeks the Ace of Spades has not been selected, the Progressive Jackpot will be awarded on the 50th week of the raffle.
- b. The winning ticket holder will win 20% of the weekly ticket sales and a chance to draw for the current round's Catch the Ace jackpot.
- c. If the Ace of Spades is not selected another ticket will be drawn. This and the subsequent ticket drawn after the first ticket, will not win the weekly prize but the envelope number shown on the ticket will be eligible for the Progressive Jackpot.
- d. If the drawn ticket does not have an envelope number or has an invalid number, the Rotary Club will make one (1) attempt to contact the ticket holder at the phone number indicated on the ticket. The holder will be asked to select a number from the remaining envelopes and that card will be revealed. If unsuccessful in contacting the holder, the lowest remaining envelope number is selected by the Rotary Club.
- e. The ticket holder that reveals the Ace of Spades is declared the Jackpot Winner.
